



**Why do we do claim, cite,
clarify?**

Objective!

- * Today, we will practice claim, cite, clarify in order to support claims with text evidence.

CLAIM

- * **The claim is where you ANSWER the question.**

- * **If it's asking you to take a stance, TAKE A STANCE.**

- * **Let's look at an example.**

- * In paragraph 6, the author describes the situation as a game. Why does he choose to make this sort of comparison?

- * **MY CLAIM:** He makes it a game because they lost stuff.

Cite

* Use a piece of evidence from the text or your research that **PROVES** your claim.

* **DO NOT USE A RANDOM QUOTE.**

* **USE PROPER FORMATTING OR I WILL TAKE OFF POINTS.**

* *Cite: The author writes it seemed as if he had taken all of his mother's strength—had left nothing for those that might come after him."*

Clarify

- * **Explain your quote and how it relates to your claim.**
- * **This can be one sentence or 4 depending on how much you need to explain in order to make your point.**
- * **Do not be redundant.**
- * *The narrator describes it as a game because it's like they have been playing something but they're losing what they're playing. They are losing their hopes and dreams. They are not winning the game.*

- * Write a Claim, Cite, Clarify answering this question.**
- * You can ask for help as you do this today!**
- * The question is: In paragraph 6, the author describes the situation as a game. Why does he choose to make this sort of comparison?**
- * I have additional questions about the chapter for when you finish.**
